Nestled on the edge of the spectacular Lokobe Nature Special Reserve, Lokobe Forest Camp (often referred to locally as Djema Lodge) offers a true eco-lodge experience surrounded by rainforest, wildlife, and traditional Malagasy culture. It is ideal for nature lovers, birdwatchers, hikers, photographers, and travelers wanting a quieter, more authentic side of Nosy Be



PACKING CHECKLIST

- Light clothing (humid climate)
- Mosquito repellent
- Lightweight hiking/ walking shoes
- Flip flops/ Sandals or water shoes
- Light weight jacket
- Sunscreen and hat
- Waterproof bag
- Flashlight/headlamp
- Cash (Ariary) for guides and small purchases
- Power bank

GOOD TO KNOW

- Lokobe Forest Camp / Djema Lodge is typically a rustic eco-style accommodation rather than a luxury resort. Expect simple but comfortable bungalows or forest camp with a nature-focused atmosphere
- There is no hot water available in the showers. However, the water temperature in Madagascar remains naturally warm.
- The lodge does not provide beach towels, so guests should bring their own.
- Mosquito nets are provided in all rooms



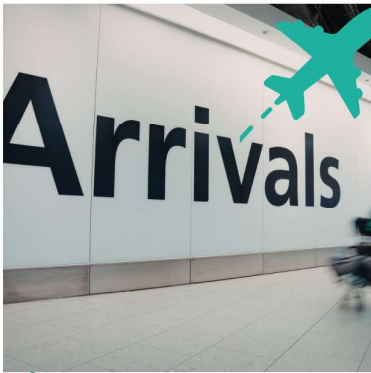

ARRIVALS

On arrival at Fascene Airport:

- Visa on arrival: €25 (≤ 14 nights) / €35 (longer stays) payable in euro or by credit card
- Immigration is slow but straightforward -complete the immigration form prior to arrival to speed this process up.
- Collect bags → exit into a small arrivals area
- Outside arrivals: Look for your driver holding a sign with your name or hotel
- No need to engage with unofficial taxi offers
- ATM: There is an ATM at the airport — use it here if needed



BAR & DRINKS

- There is an honesty bar selling beer, soft drinks and water
- 1.5lt of water is given on arrival, per guest for free
- As not all alcoholic drinks are always available on the island, guests are welcome to bring their own spirits. No corkage fee will be charged



POWER & WIFI

- Electricity: Phones and cameras are charged using solar during the day. There is a charge point in the bar.
- Wi-Fi: Currently there is no Wi-Fi, however, one can just use a local SIM card.

MONEY & TIPPING

Tipping guidelines

- Tipping is not compulsory, but appreciated.

Money

- Currency: Malagasy Ariary (MGA)
- Euros widely accepted in tourism areas
- Outside of resort- card payments not reliable, assume cash
- No card payments are accepted at Lokobe Camp
- Accepted currencies Euros, USD and Ariary.
